# **Notice Concerning Usury Rate**

Effective July 1, 2013, the provisions of K.S.A. 16-207 are revised (2013 Session Laws of Kansas, Chapter 103). The floating cap is removed on the interest rate charged for first real estate mortgage loans and contracts for deed to real estate, and the obligation is removed of the secretary of state to publish notice of the maximum effective rate of interest per annum for notes secured by all real estate mortgages and contracts for deed to real estate. The parties will be subject to continuing law which provides a rate that cannot exceed 15.0 percent per annum, unless otherwise specifically authorized by law.

# Request for Qualifications, #40348 K-State Student Union Renovation and Expansion

The KSU Foundation solicits Statements of Qualifications for programming and conceptual design services from qualified firms who have experience and expertise needed to prepare a detailed architectural program for the renovation and expansion of the K-State Student Union. The firms and/or individual selected to provide services for this initial programming and conceptual design phase will be eligible to participate in the selection process for subsequent design and construction phases.

# **Project Description**

The K-State Student Union at Kansas State University is the living room for the campus community and provides facilities, services, programs and leadership opportunities, and builds a sense of community to enhance the quality of life for its students, faculty, staff, alumni and guests, with particular emphasis on students.

Total project cost is expected to be \$21-25 million, with the majority of funding coming from a student privilege fee increase per semester with a total existing building of 263,639 square feet.

A Union Master Plan study conducted by Ayers Saint Gross Architect and Planners, from Baltimore, Maryland, was completed in February 2013. The scope of work of this master plan included a building analysis, stakeholder interviews, assessment of food service capacity and future demand. This analysis resulted in a developed proposed space needs program, conceptual plans, cost estimate and conventional renderings.

The selected team will work with a Union Renovation Committee consisting of representative staff, students and faculty to develop and present a comprehensive architectural Building Program, Conceptual Design and Phasing/Sequencing recommendations for the renovation and building addition project. The selected team shall work with the KSU Campus Planning and Facility Management to determine MEP requirements and campus infrastructure impact of the project.

Qualification submittals are due by 2 p.m. Friday, July 26, 2013, to the Kansas State University Purchasing Office, 21 Anderson Hall, Manhattan, 66506.

The permits are written for non-urban and urbanized areas in Kansas based on the 2010 U.S. census and the designation criteria in 40 CFR Parts 122 and 123. General permit G-FST-0604-SO01 is written for applicants receiving a MS4 permit for the first time. General permit G-SCD-0604-SO01 is written for the permittees who are receiving a reissued permit.

A general stormwater permit is provided for those entities engaged in similar activities and discharging stormwater of similar quality. A general permit is placed on public notice once during the life of the permit and then is made available, without further public notice, to all qualified entities that meet the requirements of the permit. The permittees are also required to meet all other federal, state and local requirements.

The small MS4 general permit program addresses MS4s that generally serve populations less than 100,000

in urbanized areas, and those MS4s located outside of urbanized areas that have or may have the potential to negatively impact surface water quality as a result of their discharges.

Both general permits require the permittee to develop, implement and enforce a stormwater management plan (SMP) designed to reduce the discharge of pollutants from the MS4 to the maximum extent practicable, to protect water quality, and to satisfy the appropriate water quality requirements of the Clean Water Act and Kansas law. The SMP covers the six minimum stormwater control measures and also requires implementation of best management practices (BMPs) for discharges of stormwater to designated total maximum daily load (TMDL) streams and lakes in the immediate area downstream of or within the municipality. The SMP document must address the BMPs to be implemented by the permittee, provide measurable goals for the BMPs, designate the municipality or municipalities responsible for implementing the control measures, provide appropriate maps, and conduct stormwater/receiving stream sampling and testing based upon the TMDL impairments. The draft permits contain schedules of compliance requiring the development and submittal of the various documents to KDHE and implementation of practices to control stormwater pollution from the MS4.

The seller of a non-virgin bull will bear testing costs of the animal to validate that it is free of the tritrichomonas organism. Testing costs are currently the responsibility of owners to meet import requirements of other states.

K.A.R. 22-4-5. Adoption by reference. This proposed regulation adopts the National Fire Protection Association's "Explosive Materials Code" (NFPA 495), with exclusions and modifications. NFPA 495 provides a comprehensive code governing the manufacture, distribution, storage, and use of explosive materials. K.A.R. 22-4-5 will require manufacturers, distributors, users, blasters, and handlers of explosive materials to obtain a permit from the state fire marshal. The regulation will also require a permit for the temporary or permanent storage of explosive materials.

This regulation is anticipated to have a minimal economic impact on the Office of the State Fire Marshal in the immediate future, as the state fire marshal will implement these regulations using existing resources. The regulation may have a minimal economic impact on other units of government; while the regulation does not govern the use of explosive materials by government entities acting in a public safety capacity, NFPA 495's storage, recordkeeping, and permitting requirement will apply. The regulation may have a minimal to modest economic impact on private persons. The provisions of NFPA 495 are based on existing federal law, generally recognized safe practices, and industry standards. As such, the most significant economic impact of the regulation will fall on those who are not currently using explosive materials in a safe and responsible manner.

K.A.R. 22-4-2, K.A.R. 22-4-3 and K.A.R. 22-4-4 (revocations). These regulations are being revoked. K.A.R. 22-4-2 currently requires a permit for the storage of explosive materials. This requirement will be consolidated with the storage requirements of NFPA 495 in K.A.R. 22-4-5. K.A.R. 22-4-3 is a definition regulation that is no longer necessary, and K.A.R. 22-4-4 contains outdated rules governing the purchase of explosive materials in another state. The revocation of these regulations is not anticipated to have any economic impact.

# Regulations Proposed for Amending: Definitions for Adult Care Homes and Their Employees

K.A.R. 26-39-100. Definitions. The amendment to this KDADS regulation specifies its applicability to both adult care homes and their employees, with the following revisions incorporated: 1) definition for "concentrated livestock operation"; 2) terminology changes to "intermediate care facility for people with intellectual disabilities" and "advanced practice registered nurse"; and 3) changes of the department's name to Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services, and regulatory references for nurse aide and medications aides.

# New Regulations: Health Occupation Credentialing Regulations — Unlicensed Employees in Adult Care Homes

**K.A.R. 26-50-10. Definitions.** This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-164. The regulation includes additional terms: general supervision, course supervisor; revised definitions: instructor, eligible for employment; and deleted duplicate terms defined in K.A.R. 26-39-100.

K.A.R. 26-50-12. Curricula and instruction manuals. This new regulation centralizes the Nurse Aide and Medication Aide Curriculum Guides and the respective course instruction manuals dated May 10, 2013, into a single regulation.

K.A.R. 26-50-20. Nurse aide; training program. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-165. The regulation identifies the certification of a person as a nurse aide by placement of that person's name on the Kansas nurse aide registry versus the issuance of a paper certificate. The regulation also specifies clinical instruction and demonstration of skill competency of the training course must take place in a setting that offers a full range of clinical tasks and experiences as specified in the curriculum.

K.A.R. 26-50-22. Nurse aide training course; personnel and course sponsor. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-166. The regulation presents a new structure and additional requirements for the nurse aide training course personnel that includes: 1) A course supervisor who provides general supervision of the CNA training course. The requirements for a person in this position were previously those of the course instructor. 2) An RN who is the instructor of the training course. This person must complete seven hours of professional continuing education offerings on person-centered care prior to teaching the course and annually thereafter. This replaces the current requirement of having 1,750 hours of licensed nursing experience in an adult care home or long-term-care unit of a hospital.

3) A registered nurse who has at least one year of licensed nurse experience in providing care for the elderly or chronically ill who are 16 years of age or older to whom a nurse aide trainee must demonstrate competency in all skills identified on part I of the nurse aide training and competency evaluation program task checklist.

K.A.R. 26-50-24. Nurse aide; state test. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-168. The regulation permits any entity administering the state test to charge each person a test administration fee.

K.A.R. 26-50-26. Nurse aide; out-of-state and allied health training equivalency. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-167. The statutory requirement for granting equivalency was added to this regulation.

**K.A.R. 26-50-30. Medication aide; program.** This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-169a. The regulation requires a medication aide to be at least 18 years of age.

K.A.R. 26-50-32. Medication aide course; instructor and course sponsor. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-169a.

K.A.R. 26-50-34. Medication aide; state test; registry. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-169b. The regulation specifies the eligibility requirements for a person who takes the test. The regulation also identifies the certification of a person as a medication aide on the Kansas nurse aide registry versus the issuance of a paper certificate.

K.A.R. 26-50-36. Medication aide; out-of-state and allied health training equivalency. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-169a.

K.A.R. 26-50-38. Medication aide; certification renewal and reinstatement; notification of changes. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-169c. The regulation requires a person whose certification as a medication aide has been expired for more than one year to retake the medication aide course and state test for reinstatement of their certification.

K.A.R. 26-50-40. Medication aide; continuing education course. This new regulation corresponds to existing KDHE regulation K.A.R. 28-39-169c.
