A public hearing will be conducted at 8:30 a.m. Wednesday, September 2, in the second floor auditorium at Memorial Hall, 120 S.W. 10th Ave., Topeka, to consider amendments to Kansas Administrative Regulation 7-23-14 and provide for the adoption of Kansas Administrative Regulation 7-23-15. These regulations pertain primarily to proof of citizenship requirements for newly registered voters and to voter registration applications that have been determined to be incomplete.

This 60-day notice of public hearing shall constitute a public comment period for the purpose of receiving written public comments on the proposed regulations. The Kansas Department of Health and Environment received an application from Butler County to modify the Butler County Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (MSWLF) Permit No. 100. The landfill is located at 2963 S.W. 40th St., El Dorado, Kansas.

The approximately 320-acre facility is located in Section 28, Township 26 South, Range 5 East, in Butler County. It currently consists of an approximately 33-acre closed MSWLF disposal unit in the northwest quarter of the site and an approximately 70-acre composite liner designed disposal area to the south of the closed unit. The requested modification will permit disposal in the approximately 5-acre valley area between the closed and active MSWLF units. This modification requesting a 5-acre increase in disposal area would result in an increase in permitted disposal capacity from about 7.1 million cubic yards to about 12.3 million cubic yards. It also would increase the final elevation of the landfill by about 50 feet from 1,370 feet to about 1,420 feet above mean sea level.

The Butler County chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and the Butler County director of community development have certified that the modification requested is consistent with the Butler County Solid Waste Management Plan and compatible with surrounding land use, respectively.

In accordance with K.A.R. 28-29-6a, KDHE is providing public notice of its intent to modify Butler County's solid waste landfill permit to allow the modifications described herein. However, a final decision to modify the permit has not been made, and KDHE will consider information gathered during the public comment period before making a final decision. A copy of the permit application; engineering drawings, which include a map of the facility; and draft permit with respect to this permit action will be available for public review at [www.kdheks.gov/waste](http://www.kdheks.gov/waste) from July 2-31, 2015. Anyone wishing to comment on the proposed modification should submit written statements by 5 p.m. July 31, 2015, to Sam Sunderraj, KDHE, 1000 S.W. Jackson, Topeka, 66612-1366; via facsimile to 785-296-1592; or via email to [ssunderraj@kdheks.gov](mailto:ssunderraj@kdheks.gov). Comments that are postmarked by July 31, 2015, and received at KDHE's Topeka offices by the close of business August 7, 2015, also will be considered.

After consideration of all formal comments as described above, KDHE will make a final decision on whether to amend the permit. Notice of the decision will be given to the applicant, to anyone who submitted formal comments and to those who requested notice of the final permit decision.
