Filing fee	The filing fee for this document is \$165.						
Payment	Please submit payment by check, money order, or credit card. Checks and money orders need to be made payable to the Secretary of State. Forms received without the appropriate fee will not be accepted for filing. Please do not send cash.

Company name	A word of organization must be included in the name per K.S.A. 17-7673. Permitted words of organization are "Limited Company," "Limited Liability Company," or the abbreviation "L.C.," "L.L.C.," "LC" or "LLC." You may view statutes at <b>www.ksrevisor.org</b> .						
	Kansas does not use "PLLC" designations.						
Resident agent  The resident agent is a person or entity that is authorized to accept service of process (laws behalf of the business entity. This does not necessarily mean that the agent himself/herself is sued, but that he/she has the authority and responsibility to accept service of process on be business.							
Registered office	The registered office is the address where the resident agent is located.						
Original certificate from the regulatory board	The certificate must be issued by the state regulatory board for each member stating that they are licensed and that the business entity name is approved.						
Purpose	The articles must include a specific professional purpose (ex. Practice of Medicine).
