STATE OBJECTIONS BOARD TO CONVENE

TOPEKA (April 8, 2011) – The Secretary of State will convene a meeting of the State Objections Board on Monday, April 11, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Secretary of State's office, Memorial Hall, 120 SW 10th Avenue, Second Floor, Topeka, Kansas.

The board will meet to review an objection filed by David Merton Shultz to the eligibility of Barack H. Obama for the office of President.

The State Objections Board is defined by statute and comprised of Secretary of State Kris W. Kobach, Attorney General Derek Schmidt and Lieutenant Governor Jeff Colyer.
