Secretary Kobach Files First Voter Fraud Cases

TOPEKA (October 9, 2015) - Kansas Secretary of State Kris Kobach has filed the first cases of voter fraud since attaining prosecutorial authority during the 2015 legislative session. One of the cases was filed in Sherman County while the other two were filed in Johnson County. The charges filed range from misdemeanor counts of voting without being qualified to felony counts of election perjury. Secretary Kobach is the first Secretary of State in the nation to attain and exercise prosecutorial authority of election crimes.
