KOBACH ENCOURAGES VOTERS TO PARTICIPATE IN 4TH DISTRICT SPECIAL CONGRESSIONAL ELECTION

Topeka (April 10, 2017) – Kansas Secretary of State Kris Kobach encourages voters to make their voices heard in the 4th District special election tomorrow, April 11th, 2017. There are 17 counties located in the 4th Congressional District – Barber, Butler, Chautauqua, Comanche, Cowley, Edwards, Elk, Greenwood, Harper, Harvey, Kingman, Kiowa, Pawnee (part), Pratt, Sedgwick, Stafford and Sumner.

There are three candidates in this election – James A. Thompson, Democratic Party; Chris Rockhold, Libertarian Party, and Ron Estes, Republican Party.
