Grant funds are available from the Federal Sexual Assault Services Grant Program (SASP) for 2011. The overall purpose of SASP is to provide intervention, advocacy, accompaniment (e.g., accompanying victims to court, medical facilities, police departments, etc.), support services and related assistance for adult, youth and child victims of sexual assault, family and household members of victims, and those collaterally affected by sexual assault.

This grant program recognizes the need to place increased focus on sexual assault in order to address the lack of available direct intervention and related assistance services and the unique aspects of sexual assault trauma from which victims must heal. Women and men of all ages, as well as children, can be victims of sexual assault.

Priority will be given to applicants that are rape/sexual assault crisis centers providing direct intervention and related assistance to victims/survivors, and to dual programs that provide sexual assault and domestic violence services to enhance the provision of sexual assault-related direct intervention and related assistance services.

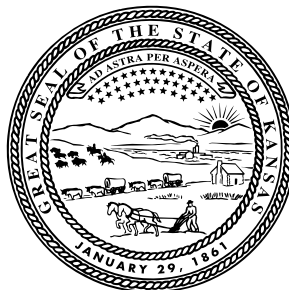

Notice is hereby given of the commencement of the selection process for civil engineering services for perimeter roadways and parking construction, Jardine Apartments, Phase 3A, Kansas State University, Manhattan. The Kansas Department of Transportation is seeking qualified consulting engineering firms or teams, prequalified in category 221 — Non-Standard Span Bridge Design (categories at www.ksdot.org/divengdes/prequal) for the project listed below. 70-105 KA-2130-01

The initial scope of this project is to study options and costs for improvements to the stretch of I-70 near the state line, known as the Lewis & Clark Viaduct. Bridge rehabilitation and/or total replacement/reconstruction need to be explored to improve highway alignments. The study is expected to take one year, potentially with design work to follow to correct alignments and to rehabilitate or replace the structure(s). Annual inspection records, recent repair plans and the latest studies will be made available to the shortlisted firms.

The Consultant Shortlist Committee will select three to five of the most highly qualified firms expressing interest and schedule an individual interview. The consulting firms can more thoroughly discuss their experience related to their qualifications, experience, approach to the project at the interview, available schedule, and the personnel to be assigned to this project. Firms not selected to be short-listed will be notified.

The Consultant Selection Committee, appointed by the Secretary of Transportation, will conduct the discussions with the firms invited to the individual interview conferences. The committee will select the firm based on qualifications to perform the professional services required for completing the advertised project. After the selection, the firms not selected will be notified of the outcome.

It is KDOT's policy to use the following criteria as the basis for selection of the consulting engineering firms:

1. Size and professional qualifications.
2. Experience of staff.
3. Location of firm with respect to proposed project(s).
4. Work load of firm.
5. Firm's performance record.

The firm's accounting systems must have the following capabilities before the firm may be awarded a contract:

- Valid, reliable and current costs must be available within the system to support cost and pricing data.
- Capability to provide a means of measuring the reasonableness of incurred costs.
- Capability to identify and accumulate allowable costs by contract or project records that will reconcile with the general ledger.
- Ability to provide supporting documentation of actual expenditures for each billing, based on costs.

Each bidder shall file a sworn statement executed by or on behalf of the person, firm, association or corporation submitting the bid, certifying that such person, firm, association or corporation has not, either directly or indirectly, entered into any agreement, participated in any collusion, or otherwise taken any action in restraint of free competitive bidding in connection with the submitted bid.

This sworn statement shall be in the form of an affidavit executed and sworn to by the bidder before a person who is authorized by the laws of the state to administer oaths. The required form of affidavit will be provided by the state to each prospective bidder. Failure to submit the sworn statement as part of the bid approval package will make the bid nonresponsive and not eligible for award consideration.

The cost/savings to employees resulting from their dependents being able to remain enrolled in the state plan longer is unknown. The KHPA estimates that this change will extend coverage to 4,662 dependents that would have been removed from the plan due to the lim-

iting age. This change would require the state to pay an additional \$362,229 in direct contributions toward the cost of health plan coverage on behalf of the members. The KHPA estimates the impact to the health care fund for claim costs to be \$1,445,810 for plan year 2011.

K.A.R. 108-1-3. School district employee health care benefits plan. K.A.R. 108-1-3 establishes the eligibility requirements for school district employees to be covered under the school district component of the SEHP. The proposed regulation change will increase the age that eligible dependents may participate in the SEHP from up to age 23 to up to age 26. This change was prompted by federal health care reform legislation, the Patient Protection & Affordable Care Act, which requires the SEHP to change the age limit and definition of an eligible dependent effective January 1, 2011.

Various definitions are also being moved to the front of the regulation.

No economic impact on the general public is anticipated. The SEHP is a self-funded health plan. Participating employers and employees pay monthly contributions into the SEHP fund. The cost/savings to employees resulting from their dependents being able to remain enrolled in the state plan longer is unknown. The KHPA estimates that this change will allow 370 dependents to remain on the plan. This change would require the school entities to pay an additional \$23,567 in direct contributions toward the cost of health plan coverage on behalf of the members with dependents between age 23 and age 26. The KHPA estimates the impact to the health care fund for claim costs to be \$109,565 for 2011.

K.A.R. 108-1-4. Local unit of government employee health care benefits plan. K.A.R. 108-1-4 establishes the eligibility requirements for nonstate public employees to be covered under the public employee component of the SEHP. The proposed regulation change will increase the age that eligible dependents may participate in the SEHP from up to age 23 to up to age 26. This change was prompted by federal health care reform legislation, the Patient Protection & Affordable Care Act, which requires the SEHP to change the age limit and definition of an eligible dependent effective January 1, 2011.

Various definitions are also being moved to the front of the regulation.

No economic impact on the general public is anticipated. The SEHP is a self-funded health plan. Participating employers and employees pay monthly contributions into the SEHP fund. The cost/savings to employees resulting from their dependents being able to remain enrolled in the state plan longer is unknown. The KHPA estimates that this change will allow 346 dependents to remain on the plan. This change would require the non-state public entities to pay an additional \$16,148 in direct contributions toward the cost of health plan coverage on behalf of the members with dependents between age 23 and age 26. The KHPA estimates the impact to the health care fund for claim costs to be \$96,568 for plan year 2011.

K.A.R. 1-65-1. Purchase of energy star products and equipment. This regulation requires state agencies to acquire products and equipment that bear the Energy Star® label if the projected cost savings for the useful life of the Energy Star® products and equipment is equal to or greater than the additional cost compared to functionally equivalent products and equipment of lower efficiency. This regulation will have minimal economic impact in that some additional time will be required to perform the tasks associated with identifying the projected cost savings for acquiring Energy Star® products and equipment.

K.A.R. 1-66-1. Definitions. This regulation identifies the definitions applicable to K.A.R. 1-66-2 and K.A.R. 1-66-3, which relate to energy audits for real property of state-owned and nonstate-owned buildings. The regulation section should have no economic impact.

K.A.R. 1-66-2. Energy audit required for each state-owned building. This regulation details the time frame that a state agency head, or that person's designee, has to conduct an energy audit of each building located on real

property owned by a state agency. The purpose of the energy audit is to determine which state-owned buildings are using an excessive amount of energy. There will be some additional time and material costs associated with the conduct of an energy audit on each state-owned building.

K.A.R. 1-66-3. Energy audit required for new lease, or lease renewal or extension, of non-state-owned real property. This regulation details the conditions under which a new lease, or lease renewal or extension, of non-state-owned real property may be approved by the secretary of administration after an energy audit is conducted. There will be some additional costs for the energy audit and, where applicable, energy conservation measures that a property owner or lessor may attempt to pass on to a governmental agency subject to the new lease, or lease renewal or extension. Some of these additional costs may be recouped over an extended period of time in the form of energy savings during the lifespan of the new lease, or lease renewal or extension.

K.A.R. 1-67-1. Definitions. This regulation identifies the definitions applicable to K.A.R. 1-67-2 and K.A.R. 1-67-3, which relate to energy efficiency performance standards for state-owned buildings. The regulation should have no economic impact.

K.A.R. 1-67-2. Energy efficiency performance standards for new construction. This regulation requires an agency architect, agency engineer, project architect or project engineer to comply with ASHRAE or IECC at the time of submission of the design development for new construction. If a functionally equivalent standard other than ASHRAE or IECC is applied, then a report verifying life-cycle cost-effective compliance must be submitted. There should be no economic impact because the Department of Administration currently requires compliance with ASHRAE or IECC, as appropriate.

K.A.R. 1-67-3. Energy efficiency performance standards for renovated, retrofitted, or repaired buildings. This regulation requires an agency architect, agency engineer, project architect, or project engineer to comply with ASHRAE or IECC at the time of submission of the design development for the renovation, retrofit or repair of each state-owned building. If a functionally equivalent standard other than ASHRAE or IECC is applied, then a report verifying life-cycle cost-effective compliance must be submitted. There should be no economic impact because the Department of Administration currently requires compliance with ASHRAE or IECC, as appropriate.

K.A.R. 1-68-1. Definitions. This regulation identifies the definitions applicable to K.A.R. 1-68-2, which relates to the purchase of a new motor vehicle during fiscal year 2011. The regulation should have no economic impact.

K.A.R. 1-68-2. Purchase of a new motor vehicle during fiscal year 2011. This regulation requires that new motor vehicles be purchased in compliance with competitive bidding statutes and life-cycle cost-effective. The regulation should result in additional fuel savings for state-owned motor vehicles.
