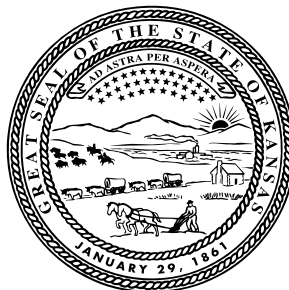

Attorney General**Opinion 2012-17**

Cities and Municipalities—General Provisions—Countywide and City Retailers' Sales Taxes; Procedure for Imposition; Election Required; Rates, General and Special Purposes, Exceptions for Certain Counties; Obligation to Submit Question Continuing Retailers' Sales Tax; Ability to Amend or Revise Purposes Stated in Original Proposition; July 30, 2012.

Synopsis: K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 12-187 does not require a county to submit the question of imposing a countywide retailers' sales tax to the electors upon passage of a ballot question directing the county commission to do so. If the electors approve a ballot question that purports requiring resubmitting the question at a future election, such question must be resubmitted to the electors to avoid a challenge on the basis of a misleading ballot. There is no statutory mechanism for a city or county governing body to modify the purpose of a local retailers' sales tax that was previously adopted by the electorate. Cited herein: K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 12-187; K.S.A. 12-195; 19-101a; 19-101c.

Constitution of the United States—Amendments to the U.S. Constitution—Rights and Immunities of Citizens; Surface and Mineral Rights Taxed Separately.

Constitution of the State of Kansas—Finance and Taxation—System of Taxation; Classification; Exemption. Taxation—Listing and Valuation of Real Estate—Surface and Mineral Rights Taxed Separately; August 8, 2012.

Synopsis: The Kansas Legislature may separately classify severed and non-severed mineral interests for taxation purposes without violating equal protection guarantees under the Kansas and United States Constitutions. Cited herein: K.S.A. 79-420; Kan. Const., Art. 11, § 1; U.S. Const., Amend. 14.

Opinion 2012-19

Constitution of the United States—Amendments to the U.S. Constitution—Amendment 1—Freedom of Religion, Speech and Press; Schools; Health Tests and Inoculations; Alternatives; Parent or Guardian Statement; Adherent of a Religious Denomination.

Constitution of the State of Kansas—Bill of Rights—Religious Liberty; Schools; Health Tests and Inoculations; Alternatives; Parent or Guardian Statement; Adherent of a Religious Denomination.

Schools—Health Programs—Health Tests and Inoculations; Certification of Completion Required, Alternatives; Parent or Guardian Statement; Adherent of a Religious Denomination; Constitutionality; August 28, 2012.

Synopsis: The alternative to mandatory inoculations provided by K.S.A. 72-5209(b)(2) does not, on its face, require membership in a religious organization or give preferential treatment to particular religious organizations, and therefore does not violate the First Amendment of the

United States Constitution. In addition, K.S.A. 72-5209(b)(2) does not, on its face, infringe upon, control, or interfere with any person's right to worship or act in accordance with religious conscience; compel any person to attend or support any form of worship; or give preference to any religious establishment, and therefore does not violate Section 7 of the Kansas Constitution's Bill of Rights. Cited herein: K.S.A. 72-5209; 72-5211a; Kan. Const., Bill of Rights, § 7; U.S. Const., Am. 1.
